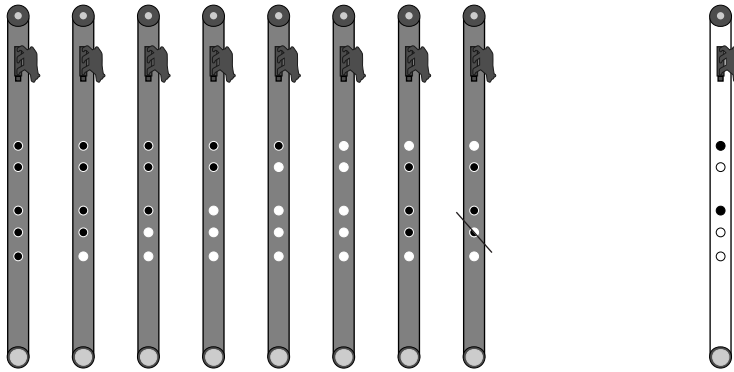


Native American Flute Scales: Standard, Tonic Major, Blues and Chromatic

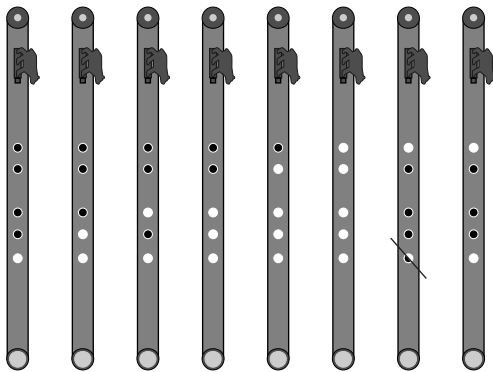
Standard



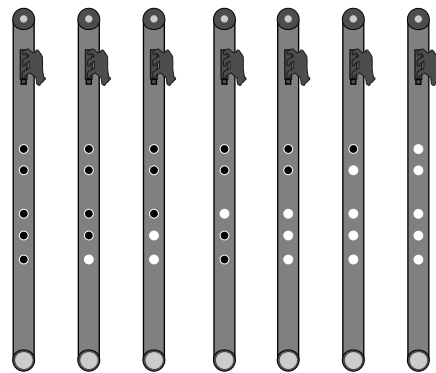
This fingering represents the note played on a “modern” 6 hole Native American Flute when uncovering the third fingering.

This is the way in which Native American Flutes are designed to be played. If you are wanting your flute to sound like the originals, it's best to keep within this range and not add too many “other notes”.

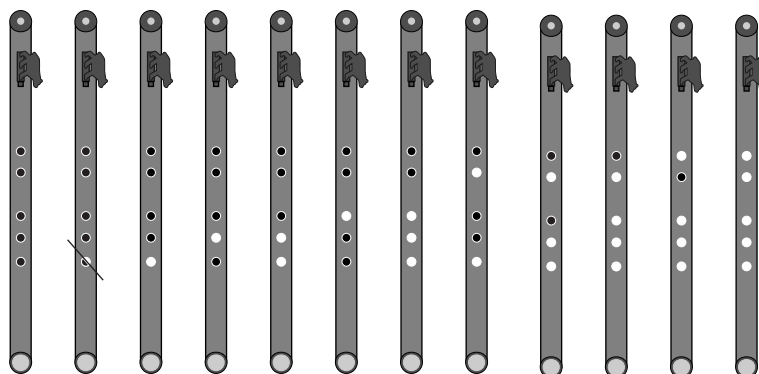
Tonic Major

This scale sheet reads from left to right where left is the lowest note and right is the highest note. Covered holes are black and un-covered holes are white. The last two notes require a little more air and practice to achieve.
