

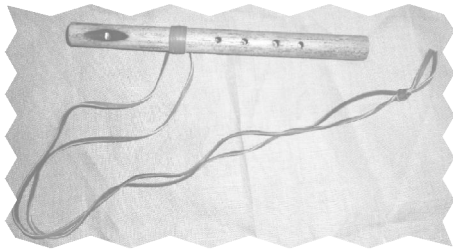
## What is a Cherokee 4-Hole Whistle?

Among the Cherokee, there were many musical instruments in our culture prior to modern times. Several of these have been lost over the years to stories and legends, though one which has remained is our 4-Hole Whistle. Such an instrument would be very precious, usually kept close to the heart and played at whenever a simple thought of happiness lept into the owner's mind.

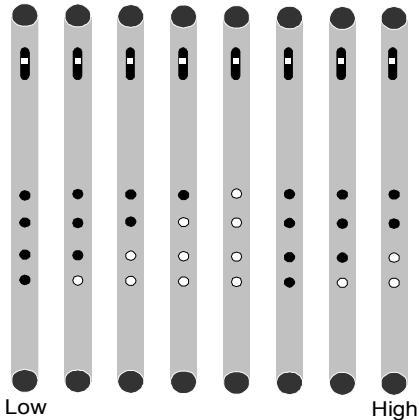
Please play your whistle in happiness and enjoy its timeless voice whenever the notion takes you.

This Cherokee Whistle has a natural finish with mineral oil, that when maintained properly can last a lifetime. The best way to keep its finish and protect the flute from cracking or drying out is to coat it inside and out with baby oil (mineral) or your favorite non-toxic oil such as olive oil once every few months.

Covered holes are black and un-covered holes are white. As you uncover the holes, leave your fingers off of the previous holes, one at a time until all are uncovered.
