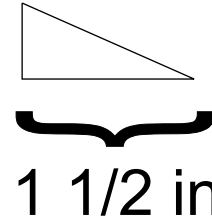
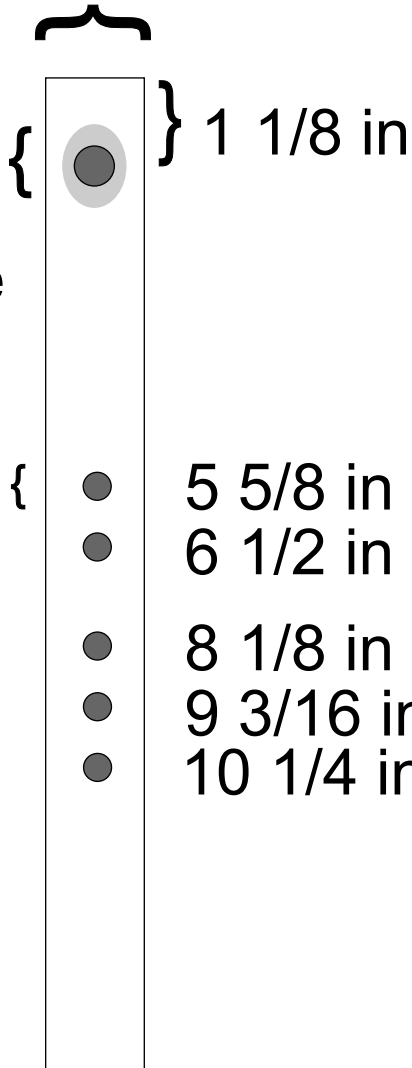


Key Of A 5 Hole Native American Flute

3/4 inch PVC

1/2 inch diameter sound hole



5/16 inch diameter fingerings

- 5 5/8 in
- 6 1/2 in
- 8 1/8 in
- 9 3/16 in
- 10 1/4 in

14 3/8 inch long

All hole measurements are made from the top of the flute. The recess around the sound hole can be made with a rolled piece of sand paper; its purpose is to make the edge of the sound hole thinner. The plug needs to be about the same diameter as the inside of the flute and pushed up to the back edge of the sound hole (the edge closest to the mouthpiece). The easiest ways to make the plug is to cut a 7/8 inch dowel to about 1 1/2 inch long and either cut a diagonal from corner to corner or sand the plug with sand paper until there is an equivalent diagonal.
